# OIKOS CHRISTMAS VILLAGE

## Christmas Brings Us Together

**\*Date & Time:** 19, 20 and 21 December 2025

**\*Location:** Oikos Coffee Lounge, Bauchrieh

**\*Target Audience:** 900 people between kids and parents

**Under the patronage** of the Jdeideh–Bauchrieh–Sed Municipality, the “Christmas Yejma‘na” or “Christmas Brings Us Together” event was held from December 19 to 21 at Oikos Coffee Lounge in Bauchrieh. The three-day celebration offered free entry and welcomed families and community members to enjoy a festive Christmas atmosphere from 4:00 PM to 11:00 PM daily.

# CHRISTMAS OUTREACH WITH TRACTS


**\*Date & Time:** December 2025
